Week 1 (February 21-26) Allowing Leaders Unchecked and Unaccountable Power/Authority

Weekly Prayer

Reflection: There are many verses that reveal Jesus undermining the cultural norm that viewed women as "less than." With this verse in mind, what does it look like to view women as co-equal heirs in Christ?

Feb 23 (Patriarchal Systems)

Reading: 1 Timothy 3:2-4, 12 & 1 Cor 7:4

Reflection: These verses speak of a husband & wife managing their homes together and having mutual authority over each other, how is this different than what you've been taught?

Feb 24 (Women in Ministry)

Reading: Acts 18:26 & Romans 16:1-4

Reflection: These passages mention just two of the women who were instrumental in leading in the early church. How have we dismissed God giving women as Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Shepherds, & Teachers to the church, for the equipping of the Saints? What has this communicated to women & those not in the Church?

Feb 25 (Celebrity Pastors)

Reading: Matthew 6:1-2, 5, 16, & James 3:16

Reflection: How have we, as a Church (locally and nationally) contributed in elevating pastors to celebrity status? How can we change that?
